OUR BURN PROGRAM

In addition to our other more traditional post-acute care services, its licensed and expert 24/7 burn care team, specialty equipment, non-institutional environment and community integration practices distinguish CareMeridian's Burn Program.

Burn victims are exposed to a much higher level of infection than other medically complex patients, requiring a higher and more flexible level of care and extensive rehabilitation. CareMeridian's Burn Care Team develops a customized program for each of its patients based on individual needs and specific challenges. Our goal is to restore functional capacity as near normal prior to the burn injury and accelerate their return to home. For those injured workers, we adapt our programs to meet the individual job requirements in an effort to more quickly return them to work.

Our licensed nursing and rehabilitation team is qualified and specially trained to treat all levels of burn patients. Specific burn-related services include:

- Wound care/dressing changes
- Pain management
- Contracture management
- Infection control

- Compression therapy
- Progressive customized splinting
- Garment care
- Wound vac therapy
- Hydration therapy
- Shower/hydro tub submerging and debridement
- Nutritional management (tube feeding/TPN/ high calorie protein diets)
- Physical, speech and occupational therapy to improve mobility, range of motion and activities of daily living
- Family/patient training and education

Finally, as our burn patients recover, CareMeridian therapists focus on community integration, working with them on much more functional activities relevant to real life.

OUR OUTCOMES

CareMeridian takes pride in its positive outcomes for burn care patients as illustrated by the following.

Wayne Wilson suffered from burns to 38 percent of his body as a result of a devastating on-the-job vehicular explosion accident. After treatment at the internationally recognized Arizona Burn Center at the Maricopa Medical Center in Phoenix, Wayne was transferred to CareMeridian Phoenix. Thanks to the expert post-acute medical care and rehabilitation he received at CareMeridian, he returned home two months later.
