CareMeridian provides a continuum of high quality, cost-effective post-acute care and rehabilitation options to people of all ages with brain, spinal cord and other life-altering injuries and medically-complex illnesses. With program locations throughout the Western United States, *CareMeridian* offers a distinctive service delivery model, merging an experienced and skilled health care and rehabilitation team with state-of-the-art technology in community-based program settings designed to meet the unique needs of those we serve at every stage of their recovery.

CareMeridian's neurorehabilitation and supported living programs in Arizona are community-based residential programs and provide services for people who have sustained a neurological injury as a result of trauma, stroke and other related medical events. Our newest location in Scottsdale (8 beds) opened in November 2010 and provides daily living assistance and support services to participants who have been discharged from a hospital or other more intensive rehabilitation facility, but still face physical, psychological and social challenges as they work towards increased independence and community integration.

CareMeridian is a partner of The MENTOR Network, a national network of local providers serving at-risk youth, individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and people with brain, spinal cord and other catastrophic illnesses and injuries in nearly 40 states.

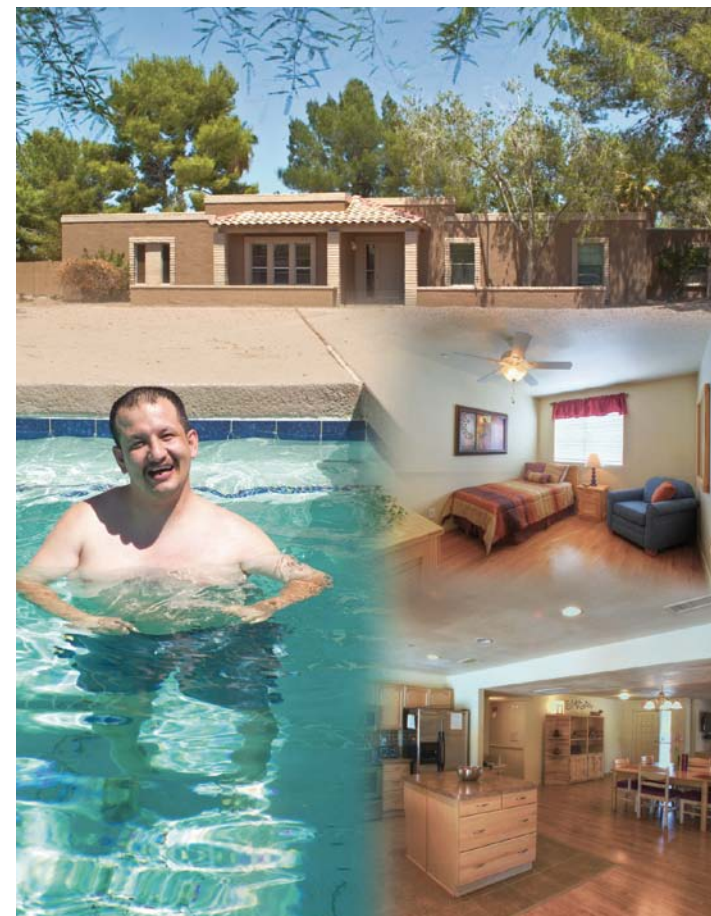
